

Questions on Jeremiah Chapter 17

1. How was Judah's sin recorded and what is the significance of this description? (v. 1)
2. What would their children "remember?" (v. 2)
 - a. What was said about their children in Jer. 7:18?
3. We recently read of "sword, famine and pestilence." However, what punishment is again discussed in verse 4 of this chapter (chapter 17)?
4. What man is "cursed?" (v. 5)
 - a. What man is "blessed?" (v. 7)
 - b. The description of the blessed man in verse 8 reminds us of David's words in Psalm 1:3. Using Psalm 1:1-2, what type of man was so blessed according to David?
5. What is the "heart" (capable of) according to verse 9?
6. Verse 10 speaks of the Lord searching and testing the mind. Who claimed this ability in Revelation 2:23? (see Rev. 2:18 for help)
7. Who is like a partridge that hatches eggs that she did not lay? (v. 11)
8. How did Jeremiah answer the people's question, "where is the word of the Lord?" (vs. 15 & 16)

9. We have before seen evidence of Jeremiah's compassion and concern for his people and outpouring of emotion (9:1). What do we now see in verse 18 of this chapter?
10. In verses 19-22, where was Jeremiah to go and what was he to tell the kings and people?
 - a. What was the response of the people? (v. 23)
11. What great promise was made to Judah if they were to observe God's Sabbath laws? (vs. 24-25)
12. What great warning was issued if they refused? (v. 27)
