

Questions on Jeremiah Chapter 19 & 20 (20 on the back)

1. Like the prophecy in the first verses of chapter 18, what type of skilled production work serves as the basis of the first several verses of the prophecy in this chapter? (see 18:2 and 19:1)
2. What item was Jeremiah to purchase and what was he to do with it after his prophecy? (verses 1 & 10)
 - a. What did this item and action represent? (v. 11)
 - b. What sins of Judah are again cited in verses 4 and 5?
 - c. How would the “Valley of Hinnom” be renamed? (v. 6)
3. We noticed in 18:12 that the people had wicked plans. What would God do to these plans? (19:7)
4. What would God *make* the city of Jerusalem according to verse 8?
 - a. What would God make the city of Jerusalem *like*, according to verse 12?
5. What horrible consequence of the protracted Babylonian siege of Jerusalem is mentioned in verse 9?
6. What all “houses” would be defiled and made like Topheth? (v. 13)
7. Jeremiah uttered this prophecy in Topheth (v. 14). What was significant about this place according to Jer. 7:31?

Questions on Jeremiah Chapter 20

1. Who was Pashhur according to verses 1 and 6?
 - a. What did Pashhur do to Jeremiah and why? (vs. 1 & 2)
 - b. How was Pashhur renamed? (v. 3)
 - c. What would happen to Pashhur and his friends and family? (vs. 4 & 6)
 - d. Is this the only “Pashhur” in the book of Jeremiah? (see 21:1)
2. What would happen to the treasures of Jerusalem? (v. 5)
3. In another lament (possibly going back to a misunderstanding of 1:18), Jeremiah complains about what? (vs. 7 & 8 & 10)
 - a. However, what was Jeremiah still compelled to do? (v. 9)
4. What did Jeremiah then remember about God? (v. 11)
5. As we saw in 17:10, what does God “see” according to 20:12?
6. What does Jeremiah again lament in verses 14-18?
 - a. What reason did he give for this in verse 18?
